Director of Coaching



Overview

The primary purpose of the Director of Coaching is to provide relevant and valued coach support in the club environment, and to monitor, inform of educational opportunities and mentor coaches to conduct appropriate quality football activities that will enhance the players and coaches experience.

Responsibilities

1. Develop, maintain and support a positive club coaching culture.
2. Promote inclusive practice within the coaching at the club.
3. Monitor and mentor club coaches and provide support based on their requirements.
4. Build a supportive network of female coaches within their club either through regular 1 on 1, group check ins or management of a group chat.
5. Communicate appropriate resources and development opportunities. This includes association coach education, NWSFdna.com and NWS Spirit FC coach education.
6. Assist with the development of coaches by providing feedback on their progress.
7. Liaise with Association representatives and attend workshops/meetings in relation to the DOC role.
8. Report back to their club Committee, including progress of coaches and any issues.
9. Support the retention of coaches over multiple seasons
10. Develop an assistant DOC to increase the development of coaches in the club and as a part of succession planning for the DOC position.
11. When a handover of positions occurs, that an appropriate handover is completed, including ensuring the incoming person is trained and supported
